**SYLLABUS FOR THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION – 2025.**  
(As per UPSC Preliminary Examination)

**SECTION – 1**  
**GENERAL STUDIES – 1 : PAPER – 1 (50 Questions, 100 Marks)**

A total of 50 Questions will be on the following topics carrying 2 marks for each question :

1. Current events of national and international importance.
2. History of India and Indian National Movement.
3. Indian and World Geography-Physical, Social, Economic Geography of India and the World.
4. Indian Polity and Governance-Constitution, Political System, Panchayati Raj, Public Policy, Rights and Issues, etc.
5. Economic and Social Development-Sustainable Development, Poverty, Inclusion, Demographics, Social Sector Initiatives, etc.
6. General Issues on Environmental ecology, Biodiversity and Climate Change-that do not require Subject specialization.
7. General Science.

**SECTION – II**  
**GENERAL STUDIES – II : (40 Questions, 100 Marks)**  
**Civil Services Aptitude Test (CSAT)- Paper – 2**

A Total of 40 questions will be on the following topics carrying 2.5 marks for each question:

1. Comprehension
2. Interpersonal skills including communication skills
3. Logical reasoning and analytical ability
4. Decision making and problem solving
5. General mental ability
6. Basic numeracy (numbers and their relations, orders of magnitude, etc.) (Class x level),  
Data interpretation (Charts, Graphs, Tables, Data Sufficiency etc. – Class x level)

**Note – 1**

Section-II (CSAT) will be a qualifying paper with minimum qualifying marks fixed at 33%

**Note – 2**

Both the question paper will be of the objective type (multiple choice questions.)

**Note – 3**

It is mandatory for the candidate to appear in both the papers of Entrance Examination for the purpose of evaluation. Therefore a candidate will be disqualified in case he/she does not appear in both the papers of Entrance Examination.
